### Weekly Drilling Report - Sunbeam 1 Exploration Well

Buru Energy Limited (Buru Energy) provides the following weekly update on drilling operations at the Sunbeam 1 well as at 06:00hrs, 5 February 2015 (AWST). Since the last progress report, the well has been drilled ahead in  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (216mm) hole to the first casing point and 7" (178mm) casing has been run and cemented to a measured depth of 612 metres. The well has then been drilled ahead in 6-1/8" (156mm) hole to a measured depth as at 06:00 hours today of 828 metres. The forward operation is to drill ahead to the primary objective.

The Sunbeam 1 well is located in exploration permit EP 129, and completion of the well will satisfy the Year 4 work commitment on that permit. Buru Energy has a 100% equity interest in the well and in EP 129. The well is located some 85 kilometres south east of Derby and some 18 kilometres south of the Gibb River Road.


