SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES \$35M INSTITUTIONAL PLACEMENT

BURU FORWARD PROGRAM FULLY FUNDED

Buru Energy Limited ("**Buru**" or "**Company**") is pleased to announce that it has successfully raised \$35 million through the placement of new shares ("**New Shares**") to institutional investors ("**Institutional Placement**") and its forward program is now fully funded

The Institutional Placement priced at \$1.65 per share, a 8.8% discount to the 5-day VWAP of \$1.81. The bookbuild was supported by new and existing Buru shareholders and closed multiple times oversubscribed.

Buru will issue 21.3 million New Shares, representing approximately 7.8% of the Company's existing issued capital, and the New Shares will rank equally with existing shares from allotment. Settlement of the Institutional Placement is expected to take place on Wednesday 14 August 2013, with allotment expected on Thursday 15 August 2013.

Proceeds raised from the Institutional Placement, together with the balance of the funding package announced by Buru on 8 August 2013, will provide Buru with the capital to progress the development of the Ungani Oilfield into full scale production, to complete an appraisal program of the Laurel Wet Gas project, and to recommence an active seismic and drilling exploration program for conventional oil prospects, with an initial focus on the Ungani oil trend. Buru's forward program is now funded in a manner which provides certainty, results in limited shareholder dilution, and supports independent activity across the Company's oil development, wet gas appraisal and oil and gas exploration assets. The funding includes an appropriate mix of equity, senior debt, and support from the Company's partners.



Commenting on the Placement Buru's Managing Director, Dr Keiran Wulff said:

"We are very pleased with the strong level of support shown for the Institutional Placement. We are delighted to welcome the new institutional investors to the Buru register. The Buru Board also believed that it was important for our existing shareholders to have the opportunity to participate in this capital program. We are very appreciative and acknowledge their ongoing support for the Company.

Following a successful early phase of Buru's development the Company is now entering its planned next stage of growth focused on targeted work programs that will deliver value from our oil development assets, appraise our gas potential, evaluate our highest value exploration opportunities and continue to mature our other exploration assets to be able to realise their value.

We are particularly pleased to be now fully funded for our next program phase to deliver these opportunities for all stakeholders."

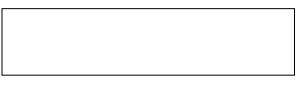
